



There is a very serious violation of the civil rights of perhaps tens of thousands of Americans that demands an immediate, in-depth congressional investigation.

The San Francisco Examiner has reported that the FBI and the San Francisco Police Department (SFPD) are conducting a criminal investigation of illegal surveillance of American citizens by the Anti-Defamation League (ADL) of B'nai B'rith, in collaboration with the ADL's contacts in police departments around the country. (See the Examiner article reproduced on the reverse side of this letter.)

The FBI and the SFPD raided the ADL's offices in Los Angeles and San Francisco and discovered that the ADL had in its possession illegally acquired files taken from more than twenty police departments in the state of California alone.

The evidence indicates that the ADL's illegal penetration of police departments is taking place on a national level.

There are names of some 12,000 Americans in the ADL files that are now in the custody of the SFPD alone. How many hundred thousand names are in ADL files around this country?

This sounds like the kind of thing that happens in a totalitarian police state.

The fact that the San Francisco investigation has already revealed that the ADL is conducting this operation on a national basis demands that a national Congressional inquiry be undertaken to get to the bottom of this scandal.

I am urging you to call for a full-dress Congressional inquiry into this scandal.

Please advise me as to what immediate action you will take to end this massive violation of American civil liberties.
