[ ] WAS IMMEDIATELY APPRISED OF THIS THREAT, AND, THEREUPON, ADVISED PERSONNEL OF THE ADL OFFICE TO EVACUATE THEIR SPACE. THE PRUDENTIAL BUILDING SECURITY COORDINATOR SEARCHED THE ADL OFFICE SPACE, BUT NO BOMB DEVICE WAS FOUND. THE SOUTHFIELD POLICE DEPARTMENT WAS ALSO NOTIFIED OF THE THREAT.

[ ] FURTHER ADVISED THAT ON THE SAME DAY, PRECEDING THE THREATENING TELEPHONE CALL, TWO OR THREE SERVICE REPAIRMEN WERE IN THE ADL OFFICE SPACE. ONE OF THESE SERVICEMEN APPEARED TO ACT RATHER SUSPICIOUSLY WHILE FIXING A TYPEWRITER, THAT IS, HE ASKED A LOT OF QUESTIONS OF ADL PERSONNEL. [ ] ADVISED THAT THE ADL HAS A KU KLUX KLAN AND NAZI DISPLAY IN ITS OFFICE.

LATER THAT SAME DAY, PRECEDING THE BOMB THREAT BUT AFTER THE SERVICEMEN HAD LEFT, THE ADL OFFICE RECEIVED AN ANONYMOUS TELEPHONE CALL. THE CALLER STATED, "YOU'VE GOT THAT KLAN STUFF AND I'M GOING TO CALL AN INSPECTOR."

On January 28, 1987, at approximately 5:30 P.M., an anonymous telephonic bomb threat was received by the Prudential Town Center operator. The bomb threat was as follows: "There is a bomb in the Anti-Defamation League Office". The caller then hung up.

The Anti-Defamation League (ADL) Office was evacuated and a search of their office space by the Prudential Town Center Security staff failed to locate a bomb device.

The Southfield, Michigan, Police Department was notified regarding this incident.

The anonymous caller was described as a middle age Caucasian male, who appeared to be educated.

On February 6, 1987, [redacted] Secretary for the ANTI DEFAMATION LEAGUE (ADL), 4000 Town Center, Southfield, Michigan, telephone number (313) 355-3700, was interviewed by Special Agent (SA) [redacted] regarding a telephone bomb threat received by the ADL on January 28, 1987.
