Dear Gottlieb:

Enclosed is the accounting regularly due on October 1, which now takes into consideration the reduced allocation and all the adjustments resultant therefrom. (Please see my September 11th accounting and the subsequent letter of September 18th).

Once again, I want to call to your attention that more than one-half of the total requested goes for the unpaid balance and extra amounts not part of our regular budget. Indeed, these extra amounts -- exclusive of the unpaid balance, of course -- are monies that we are expected to advance and then request reimbursement. It is literally impossible for us to do this, particularly when we do not even receive in any given month the regular allocation due to us. For instance, during September we received a total of \$46,000.00. Our regular allocation, exclusive of extra amounts not part of the budget, comes to \$48,875.00. Thus, we are building up -- largely because of commitments for which we are not responsible and the unpaid balance due to us -- an ever increasing amount "past due".

I know how serious the problem is, but I earnestly plead that every effort be made during October to pay the total requested so that we can once and for all go on a regular basis and have the wherewithal to meet the additional commitments which are constantly required of us.
