[redacted] has been employed for some time by the local
Anti-Defamation League as a part-time investigator. I have known
him for about six months and have found him to be sincere.

On August 22, 1940, he called at the office, and in the
course of his conversation said that he had been instructed by
DAVE BLACKER, one of the leaders in the local Anti-Defamation
League and the publisher of the Jewish Press at 534 Brandeis Theatre
Building, Omaha, never to disclose to the FBI or any other source
that he is so employed. BLACKER gave as his reason that the
Anti-Jewish element has accused the Anti-Defamation League of
having private investigators, and the Anti-Defamation League does
not wish it to become generally known that they do employ private
investigators.

Reference is made to the letter addressed to this office from the Chicago Office, dated August 23, 1940, with which there was transmitted a list of names submitted by SAM SIEVERS, representative of the Anti-Defamation League in St. Louis, to MILES M. GOLDBERG of the Anti-Defamation League, Chicago, Illinois, and, in turn, furnished to the Chicago Office.

A review of the information contained in this list indicates that a part of it was furnished by RICE A. PIERCE, formerly employed by Anheuser-Busch, Inc., St. Louis, Missouri, and an informant of SAMUEL I. SIEVERS, Jewish attorney and Chairman of the Anti-Defamation League, Boatmen's Bank Building, St. Louis, Missouri. Over a period of many months, PIERCE has submitted several hundred written reports to this office regarding persons suspected by him of un-American activities.

Although RICE A. PIERCE comes of a rather prominent family, he is regarded as mentally unbalanced by agents of this office who have contacted him. It was Mr. SIEVERS who originally referred him to this office in order that we might have the benefit of information furnished by him. A great majority of this information, on the face of it, is evidently unreliable. However, some of the information contained in the list furnished by Mr. SIEVERS may be regarded as fairly accurate, as indicated by the files of the St. Louis Office.

Please be advised that PIERCE died at St. Louis, Missouri, on July 17, 1940.

I had a long talk with one of the officials of the Department of Immigration. They have recently been instructed, by Washington, to cooperate with the other government agencies in combatting fifth column activities. They are now seeking evidence on any individual who is still an alien, who has been engaged in subversive work, so that they can recommend the refusal of citizenship papers, when, as, and if, these people come up for such application.

The recent legislation with reference to the registration of aliens has sent a great alarm through the ordinary ranks of the members of the ODWU. Many of them are beginning to realize for the first time that belonging to a questionable organization will jeopardize their chances for either obtaining citizenship or maintaining their jobs.

Inasmuch as the proof as to the character of the ODWU and Hetman organizations, now in the hands of the FBI, is sufficient to show that these groups are definitely tied up with the German Nazi government, I believe it would be a good idea to submit the names of whatever members we have on file to the Immigration authorities, so that they can take proper action. After all, the FBI can only keep the information on file until such time as circumstances make action necessary.

The Immigration Bureau, however, can act effectively now. I am, therefore, submitting the names of those individuals within the New York area and have received a promise from the authorities that they will take action immediately.

Another good purpose will be served when the word spreads through the groups that the United States Immigration Department is investigating them. This will undoubtedly cause wholesale resignations and either completely crack the groups or sap them of much of their strenght.

They say of Wythe Williams, Mutual news analyst, that "he gets it first and gets it right," in view of his astonishing ability for pulling newsbeats out of the summer air and presenting them to Mutual listeners. Williams' newsbeats are of two kinds. He breaks many sensational stories of what already has taken place behind the banks of regular newsmen. But more often he tells the story before it happens. He crawls way out on a limb and makes startling predictions of what will take place in the future. To date 96% of all his predictions have come to pass.

Nobody has ever made a record of all Williams' newsbeats, but there are many of them. Below are four outstanding ones scored recently which have been acknowledged in the nation's press:

GOEBBELS HORSEWHIPPED...On December 28, 1938, Williams, then editor of "Greenwich Time," broke the news that D. Joseph Goebbels, German Propaganda Minister and Number 2 Nazi, had been horsewhipped by an indignant husband whose wife Goebbels had dishonored.

WAR DECLARED... As guest on a "Hobby Lobby" program early in August, 1939, Williams told Lowell Thomas that Europe would be embroiled in another war by September 6. England and France declared war September 3.

STALIN SIGNS WITH HITLER...As early as June 20, 1939, Williams predicted the about-face in Russian foreign policy which made possible Hitler's aggression in Poland after war was declared.

DENMARK INVADED...On Feb. 28, 1940, Williams predicted the invasion of Denmark within a short time. Denmark was invaded April 8.

This is the first information which we have had indicating a lack of cooperation and accordingly I talked to SAC Devereaux who informs me that he has lunch once or twice a week with Miles Goldberg, the head of the Anti-Defamation League and also is well acquainted with Richard Gutstadt. He stated that definitely they have fine cooperation and accordingly I told him in the near future to casually mention that information had come to our attention that some people believed that we were not cooperating, that apparently this information had come from Mr. Harry Elhman. I told him to also endeavor if he possibly could to talk to Elhman personally. He stated he would do this.

MEMORANDUM FOR MR. TOLSON

I recently talked to SAC Devereaux on Isadore Slavin and one Ehlman.

You will recall that Slavin called upon you and indicated that the Bureau wasn't cooperating with B'nai B'rith and the Anti-Defamation League.

Paul Richman told me that no individuals by this name was well known in Chicago.

Later this afternoon Devereaux called stating that he had talked to you about Slavin yesterday and he has since talked to Slavin and Ehlman who are with the American Jewish Congress, headed by Rabbi Wise, which you will recall is the Zionist movement. In the course of the conversation it was pointed out that Sam Poyale who had contacted the Chicago Office and furnished information reported back to the Bureau and they would not give him reports of what was being done. This individual, according to Devereaux did not appear to be a very high type of person. Devereaux pointed out that the Bureau did not give reports of its activities, whereupon they countered that that is the way they deal with the police and indicated that if the Bureau did not want to cooperate in this manner that might not want to play ball.

I told Devereaux that when he met with this group again he should not pull his punches and we are operating the Bureau and will continue to operate it as in the past and while it might be possible to furnish them with some information informally, we certainly could not bind ourselves with any agreement.

He said that he is having his men ascertain the present location of these individuals, after which time all information will be furnished to SAC Devereaux in Chicago.

Reference is made to telephone conversation had by the writer with Mr. Nichols of the Bureau, as well as with Mr. Tolson, concerning information supposedly furnished by Izzie/Slavin to the effect that this Office has been uncooperative with the Anti-Defamation League.

I wish to inform that contact has been had with Izzy Slavin, as well as Harry A./Ehlman, who is the source of Mr. Slavin's original information. Mr. Ehlman is in no way affiliated with the Anti-Defamation League or the B'nai B'rith. He is, however, on the Board of Directors of an organization known as the American Jewish Congress, 8 South Dearborn Street. This group more or less fashioned itself after the Anti-Defamation League and concerns itself supposedly with subversive activities.

Mr. Ehlman informed the writer that for the last three years Mr./Pollyea, the Executive Secretary of the American Jewish Congress here in Chicago had been contacting this Office. Mr. Pollyea had made the complaint to Mr. Ehlman that this Office had been uncooperative in that it did not report back to the American Jewish Congress results of the Bureau's investigations. Mr. Ehlman stated that he felt an organization such as the American Jewish Congress certainly warranted that sort of consideration - namely, that any information furnished should be added to by the Bureau as a result of any investigation that might be conducted.

It was explained to Mr. Ehlman that this Bureau could not cooperate to this extent, but that any office of the Bureau would be more than happy to accept any sort of information the American Jewish Congress might like to submit.

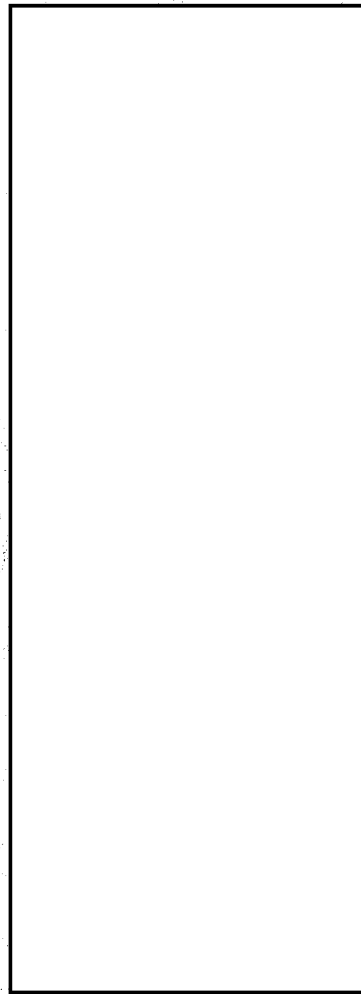
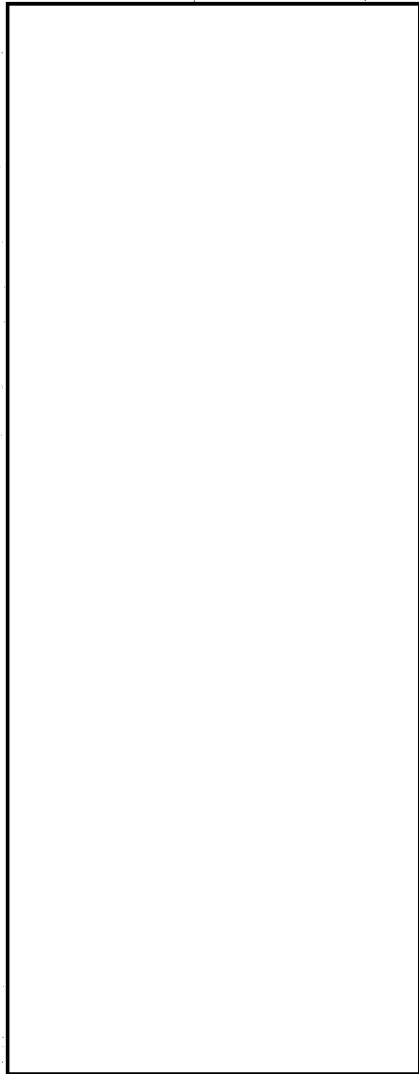
